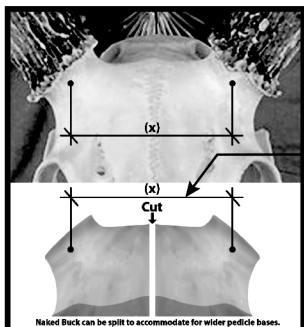
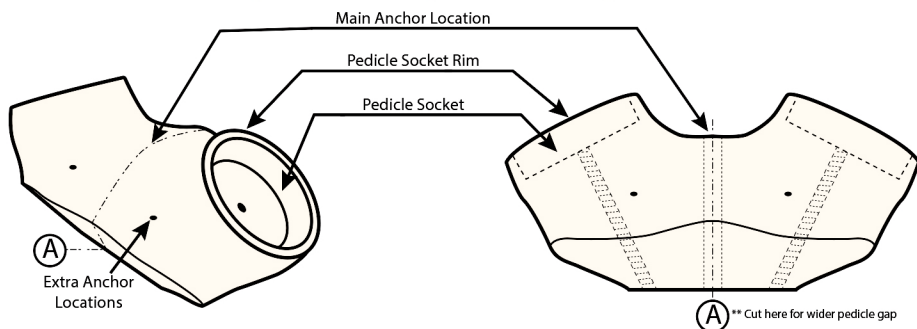
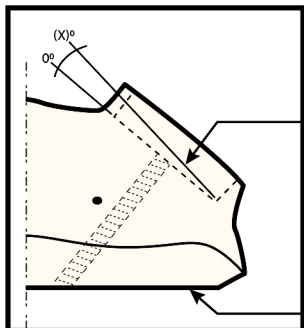




(A) Width Adjustment Option

Splitting the Naked Bull Head™ will allow you to create a wider pedicle width.

Extra anchor holes in the NBH unit are used to help secure into place.
IMPORTANT! Always predrill. NBH will chip or break if not pre drilled.



(B) Angle Adjustment Options

Forstner or Spade Bit - Slightly removing material from the inner pedicle socket base to adjust the base angle.

Wedge - Adding material within the inner pedicle socket base will adjust height of one side to change the base angle.
IMPORTANT! Very little angle adjustment goes a long way.

Height Adjustment Options

Adding material under or sanding the bottom of the Naked Bull Head™ will allow you to align to the forehead slope of your mount form.

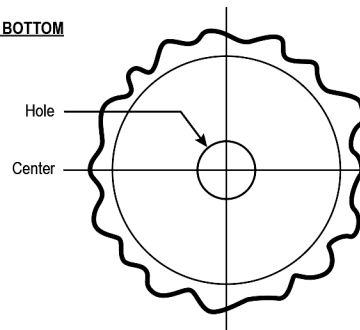

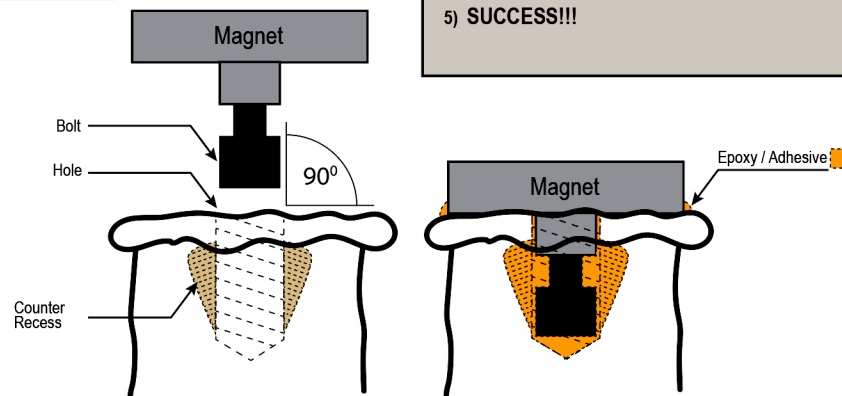

Magnet Installation - Option

- 1) Sand antler coronet flat for the magnet to have a good seating area.
- 2) Find the center of the coronet and drill a hole @ 90° only deep enough to receive the magnet with bolt.
- 3) The counter recess will help hold the bolt within the hole after epoxy has been applied.
- 4) Epoxy - Allow time for epoxy / adhesive of choice to cure for best holding results.
- 5) **SUCCESS!!!**

SOME TIPS & TRICKS

*Applying a small amount of thread lock on threads can help secure hold.

*Removing small amounts of the pedicle socket rim with a rotary sanding tool or blade will allow for better antler burr clearance. This will allow for the magnet and the steel washer within the pedicle socket to better connection.

*Epoxy or adhere magnet into place on the antler to not allow rotation.
